About AMA 424:

AMA 424 Q-500 is a low cost way to get started in R/C Pylon Racing. Planes are limited to balsa/foam wing construction. Hollow molded composite wing and tails are not allowed. The "STOCK" TT Pro .40 is currently the only legal engine on the approved list. The Great Planes Viper ARF is an excellent way to get started. 15% fuel is supplied and the Prop is limited to an APC 9X6, making performance very even. A race is 10 Laps around the course from a standing start. The course is 475' x 100' 3-Pole. Cutting inside the pylon (cut) = Extra Lap, 2 Cuts and your race is over.

AMA 428 is the Nelson/Jett Q-500 Class. 422 is the Quarter 40 or Q 40 Class.

Directions to the Barnstormers Field.

Go South on I-35 from Kansas City, at Exit 215 take US 169 South toward Paola. Exit at the Hillsdale exit and go west, thru Hillsdale, and over the Hillsdale Lake Dam. Go south on the road at the west end of the dam, take the next right and then the next left.
